Business Central supports only a single unit of measure per item, which creates a gap when dealing with variable weight products. The Catch Weight enhancement for LGS Food fills that gap.

This enhancement allows you to track products using both the base unit (like cases or boxes) and the catch weight unit (like pounds or kilograms). Whether you're breaking cases for partial orders or managing product sold by weight, this solution ensures consistent valuation and accurate sales fulfillment.

Catch weight tracking features

Item Setup

Catch weight items are defined with a base unit of measure (such as case or each) and a weight unit of measure (such as LB or KG), which are tracked separately. You can also set up unit conversions to reflect the expected weight in relation to the base UoM.

Item Tracking

Catch weight items must be lot tracked to maintain accurate inventory valuation. Assign base quantity and the catch weight quantity to ensure for accurate records.



3

Tolerances

Set tolerance thresholds for over- or under-weight receipts. If items fall outside the allowed range, the system will alert you during posting or preview posting.



4

Inventory

The item card displays both standard inventory and catch weight quantities, including on-hand values for each. Unit cost and catch weight unit cost are also shown to support accurate valuation and reporting.



5

Orders

Process catch weight items across multiple order types, including Purchase & Receipt, Sales & Shipment, Transfer, Production, and Assembly orders, with catch weight data tracked at each step.
